Conditions

1. The school has been registered under the Child Rights Education Act 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the rules made hereunder, and the accreditation has been renewed for approved class. No additional classes and additional sections are allowed to be conducted apart from these classes.
2. The school is governed by the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the Child Rights Education Act 2009 under the rules made hereunder.
3. The Child Rights Education Act 2009, as per the rules framed there under, reserves 25% of the seats for the weaker sections of the society.
The seats reserved by the government for schools falling under the purview of RTE are eligible for admission under RTE. The government has made rules to facilitate the enrollment of children in schools near the residence of their parents, and accordingly, if there are educational institutions receiving government funding, children will be enrolled in that school. In case there are none, private schools will be allowed to enroll children who are exempted from the government and continue their education up to the primary level. These children will be allowed to continue their studies without any discrimination.
4. As explained in Para 3, the government will release the fees of children enrolled under the RTE Act as per the rules. Therefore, it is prohibited to collect any fees from this school.
5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fees and donations from parents either during the admission process or later.
6. The branch/management board shall publish the fee information fixed by them on the school notice board/website and SATS as per Section 21 of the RTE Act. No fee shall be charged in excess of the prescribed fee.
7. The school administration must enroll students within the period specified by the government.
8. The school/management cannot deny admission against the following factors.

i) Due to lack of age

(ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language,

(iii) If admission is sought after an extended period of admission.

9. All safety measures as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. [Fire Safety and Building Safety Certificate from concerned authorities and Safety of Children's Learning as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R),

10. The Managing Board of the school shall not involve

(i) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school until he/she completes primary education and secondary education in the school.

(ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.

(iii) No child is required to pass any board examination until the completion of primary education.

(iv) Every child who completes primary education will be awarded a certificate as prescribed under Rule 21 of the RTE and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

(v) The school should also include children with special needs/special needs as per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

(vi) The appointed teachers shall possess the minimum educational qualifications as prescribed for primary and secondary school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.

(vii) The salary and allowances payable to the teachers and the terms and conditions of service and allowances shall be as prescribed by the State Government. The salary of the teachers shall be paid through Provident Fund (PF) and other salaries payable by the Government and shall be covered by the Employee State Insurance (ESI).

(viii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24[1] of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.

11. School must follow the educational state curriculum and state textbooks that the school is integrated with.

12. The school shall maintain the rules and norms as specified in Section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act. The departmental staff shall be appointed as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.

13. . School buildings and other infrastructure facilities related to the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-academic activities, day or night.

14. . The school should not be run for the profit of any individual or group or association.

15. . Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant and submit a copy to the Deputy Director/Block Education Officer by the end of June every year.

16. The school will follow the language policy as per the government notification (Kannada Language Policy 2016).

17. The Board of Directors and teachers shall act in accordance with the R.T.E Act and the Karnataka Education Act and Regulations.

18. The school/board of Management shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the government and department.

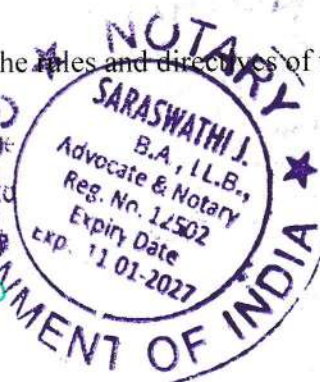
